Eligibility Requirements:

- Must reside in one of the following zip codes: 52630, 52641, 52642, 52649, 52601, 52623, 52637, 52638, 52640, 52645, 52646, 52650, 52655, 52660.
- Be a High School Graduating Senior (public, private, virtual, or homeschooled students).
 - Students who received their GED and are planning to attend college in the fall of 2024 are also welcome to apply.
- Be in good academic standing.
- Possess a valid state-issued ID Card
- The United Way does not discriminate against its applicants based on race, color, ethnicity, national origin, creed, religion, gender, sexual orientation, or disability.

Applicants Must:

- Choose between three prompts for their application essay or video submission.
- For the essay option, submissions should be no longer than 2,000 words, double-spaced, 12pt Times New Roman Font. All grammar and sentence structure will be considered.
- For the video option, submissions should be no longer than 5 minutes. Acceptable file formats are .mp4 or .avi sent via email attachments or on a USB drive. URLs to an uploaded YouTube submission will also be accepted.
- Complete Cover Page (below)
- Submit Two Letters of Recommendation.
- Provide Current High School Transcripts.

Prompts:

Applicants have the choice of three prompts for their essay or video submission. The prompts are designed to encourage thoughtful reflection on the impact of volunteerism. This allows candidates to share their unique perspectives and experiences.

Prompt 1: Innovative Approaches to Volunteerism:

Propose and discuss an innovative idea for volunteer programs that address specific community needs. Consider how technology, social media, or other contemporary tools can be leveraged to enhance the reach and impact of community service projects and volunteer efforts.

Prompt 2: The Role of Youth in Community Building:

Explore instances where young people have taken the lead in initiating and implementing community service projects. Discuss the impact of youth-led initiatives on addressing specific community needs and fostering a sense of ownership and responsibility among young volunteers. Provide examples from your own experiences.

Prompt 3: Volunteerism and Global Citizenship:

Reflect on the global implications of community service. How can local volunteer efforts contribute to global citizenship and a sense of interconnectedness among diverse communities? Share experiences from your own volunteer work that involved cross-cultural interactions.
