

Approved Items that Count towards Delivery Allocations *v.6.28.2024*

The following items are pre-approved as essential items that are acceptable for deliveries (if it adheres to other size/ weight/ packaging guidance).

Please include as many "Item Codes" as necessary to reflect what is in the delivery when scheduling orders – no need to separate Item Code by a space or comma.

Instructions for Item Codes & Approved Items

When creating a new Pick-Up Site, be sure to indicate what the primary type of item is planning on being delivered from that Local Partner. Additionally, as you schedule orders, be sure to accurately convey what is being delivered within each order by listing the corresponding acronyms of all items being delivered in Column B of your .csv template, "Order ID," followed by a unique character. For more info, refer to the Detailed Scheduling Instructions. Including item codes on each .csv file you upload to the Merchant Portal is important so we can track them for national funding commitments.

- Note: prescription medications are <u>not approved</u> for delivery at this time because DoorDash has a stringent compliance process for engaging in prescription delivery, and we do not fall within that compliance. Further, there are additional liability concerns that have not been addressed by our legal team associated with delivering prescriptions.
- Items are added to this list based on 211, local United Way, and Local Partner needs! Be creative to help meet your community's needs.

Alternate Ways to Use Deliveries/ Local Examples

Other considerations for alternative ways to utilize your delivery allocations include:

- Integration into other local United Way/211 programs.
 - For example: early childhood education programs with enrolled Clients and/or veterans enrolled in Mission United may need food support during this time.
 - Consider fundraising for food or essential items for Clients, leverage social distancing with volunteers to pack, then utilize your deliveries to get the items directly to Clients.
- Expansion to support local United Ways/ 211s across a regional or statewide territory. Note: if your agency wishes to complete this type of expansion, you must notify UWW that you are considering this route and you must have sign-off from all agencies whose service area is impacted. There are additional programmatic and grant implications that must be followed.
