United Way of Southeast Iowa Funding Application Process

The United Way of Southeast Iowa evaluates each applicant agency annually. Funding is not guaranteed based on past support. Instead, **70 volunteer Allocations Review Panel Members and Allocation Volunteers** thoroughly review every funding request through interviews and application assessments.

Funding Guidelines

Approved agencies receive funding for **specific programs**—not for general operating expenses, staff salaries, or capital improvements. Misuse of funds will result in disqualification from future funding opportunities.

Funding Timeline

- April 1, 2025 Letters of Intent Due
- May 1, 2025 Invitations to Apply Go Out
- August 1, 2025 Applications Due
 - Applications are Reviewed by Panels & Additional Questions Sent (If Necessary)
- September/November 2025 Allocation Panel Presentations
- January 2026 Notification of Approved Funding Amounts
- April 1, 2026 Payments of Approved Funding Amounts Begin
 - Letters of Intent for FY 2027 Due

Application Process

- 2. **Letter of Intent** Applicants must first submit a Letter of Intent. Selected agencies will be invited to submit a full application.
- Application Review United Way staff and volunteers review applications and prepare written questions, which must be answered via the grant website before the interview.
- Interview Stage Applicants must present their request in person before the Allocations Review Panel. Incomplete applications or failure to appear disqualifies applicants.

Interview Guidelines

Each applicant will have:

- **15 minutes** to present their request, agency, and mission.
- 15 minutes for questions from the Review Panel.

Applicants may use visual aids but should keep slides minimal and avoid reading directly from them. **No videos or pre-recorded presentations** are allowed. The interview should be conducted in an interactive format, not as a service club-style presentation.

Important Reminders

- Written materials must be submitted in full before the deadline.
- Presentations are mandatory for application completion.
- Only the current year's application form is valid.
